Born June 8, 1921 in Seattle, Washington to Toyosuke and Tamaki Onodera. Brother of Ko, Kaun, Yuta and Fumi Tsuji. Attended Washington Elementary School and Broadway High School in Seattle. Entered military service May 15, 1943 and trained at Camp Shelby, Mississippi. Member of Company C, 100th Battalion, 442nd Regimental Combat Team. Killed in action on July 5, 1944 in the Rome-Arno Campaign in Italy. Recipient of Combat Infantryman's Badge, Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Victory Medal, American Theatre Service Medal, and European-African-Middle Eastern Theatre Service Medal. Buried at Evergreen-Washelli Cemetery, Seattle.
